Definition:

Non-parent Coach - a coach who does not have a child/dependent on the team which they are coaching.

Policy:

From time to time, a minor hockey team may have a Head Coach, who does not have a child/dependent playing on the team. Some teams feel that since the person is volunteering their time to coach, the team should help cover some of the costs for fuel and meals.

The decision to compensate the non-parent coach is to take place during the team parent meeting at the beginning of the season. All parents must be in agreement and the compensation needs to be added as a line item to the team budget. The total compensated amount must not exceed \$1,600 for the season.

These expenses are the responsibility of the team with whom the Non-Parent Coach is volunteering. The Strait Richmond Minor Hockey Association <u>does not</u> cover travel expenses for Non-Parent Coaches.
